Meeting called to order at 7:00 a.m. by President Susan Lucas.

A quorum is 33 1/3% of the fifteen-member voting Board which equals five directors; this meeting had **nine** votes in the form of **eleven** directors toward a quorum. A majority vote shall be sufficient to constitute action by the Board of Directors. When a director holds more than one directorship each directorship counts toward a quorum, but the director has only one vote.

MINUTES: The minutes of the March 28, 2023, meeting stand as presented.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Presented by Gary Simmons; Financial report - The total balance in all the accounts was \$6,684,901.64 as of April 20, 2023, compared to the balance of \$6,941,339.48 as of March 23, 2023. \$10,000 was disbursed during the month for a grant to City Serve for Flood Grant. Ryan Purkiss stated that there is a misprint in LS that it did not go down 20% but was basically flat. Ryan will get together with Jeff Boswell and the investment committee to see if and what allocation changes need to be made.

OLD BUSINESS:

A.) Scholarship Committee – Susan Lucas. The Scholarship Committee had over 100 applications to go through. All Scholarships (see below who the Scholarships were

awarded to) were awarded except the Dwelle Scholarship and the scholarship committee will be meeting with all eight candidates on April 28, 2023 to determine which student will receive the scholarship. The following other scholarships have been awarded.

Alyssa Sozinho – Redwood. Cal Poly – Wants to return to Visalia to be a Music Teacher
